First aid measures

4.1 Description of first aid measures

General information:



In case of accident or unwellness, seek medical advice immediately (show directions for use or safety data sheet if possible). Remove victim out of the danger area. Keep affected person warm, still and covered. Do not leave affected person unattended. **Following inhalation:** Remove person to fresh air and keep comfortable for breathing. Following skin contact: Take off contaminated clothing. In case of skin irritation, consult a physician. Remove contaminated, saturated clothing immediately. After contact with skin, wash immediately with plenty of water and soap. In case of skin reactions, consult a physician. Following eye contact: In case of eye irritation consult an ophthalmologist. Rinse immediately carefully and thoroughly with eye-bath or water. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. Protect unharmed eye. **Following ingestion:** Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person or a person with cramps. IF SWALLOWED: Rinse mouth. Do NOT induce vomiting. Self-protection of the first aider: First aider: Pay attention to self-protection!. Most important symptoms and effects, both acute and delayed

5.1 Extinguishing media

Suitable extinguishing media:

Foam. Extinguishing powder. Carbon dioxide (CO2). Sand. **Unsuitable extinguishing media:** Strong water jet.

5.2 Special hazards arising from the substance or mixture

Formation of toxic gases is possible during heating or in case of fire.

5.3 Advice for firefighters

Wear a self-contained breathing apparatus and chemical protective clothing. Additional information

Do not inhale vapors and fumes.

Co-ordinate fire-fighting measures to the fire surroundings.

Move undamaged containers from immediate hazard area if it can be done safely.

Use caution when applying carbon dioxide in confined spaces. carbon dioxide can displace oxygen.

Use water spray jet to protect personnel and to cool endangered containers.

Collect contaminated fire extinguishing water separately. Do not allow entering drains or surface water.



6 Accidental release measures

6.1 Personal precautions, protective equipment and emergency procedures

Use personal protection equipment. Remove persons to safety. Use appropriate respiratory protection. Provide adequate ventilation.

6.2 Environmental precautions

Ensure that waste is collected and contained.

In case of gas escape or of entry into waterways, soil or drains, inform the responsible authorities. Avoid release to the environment.

Cover drains.

Ensure all waste water is collected and treated via a waste water treatment plant.

Do not allow to enter into soil/subsoil.

Do not allow to enter into surface water or drains.

Retain contaminated washing water and dispose it.

Contain leaks or spills within cabinets with removable trays.

6.3 Methods and material for containment and cleaning up

Treat the recovered material as prescribed in the section on waste disposal. Collect in closed and suitable containers for disposal. Clean contaminated objects and areas thoroughly observing environmental regulations. Ventilate affected area. Collect spillage. Absorb with liquid-binding material (e.g. sand, diatomaceous earth, acid- or universal binding agents). Wipe up with absorbent material (eg. cloth, fleece).

7.1 Precautions for safe handling

Avoid exposure - obtain special instructions before use.

PROTECTIVE MEASURES:

Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothes.

Wear personal protective clothing (see section 8).

Sewers and ducts must be protected against the entry of the product.

Do not put any product-impregnated cleaning rags into your trouser pockets.

Only allow access to authorised staff.

Provide for retaining containers, eg. floor pan without outflow.

Use only in well-ventilated areas.

If local exhaust ventilation is not possible or not enough, the entire work area must be ventilated by technical means.

Provide adequate ventilation as well as local exhaustion at critical locations.

Vapours/aerosols should be exhausted directly at the point of origin.

Avoid breathing gas/fumes/vapour/spray.

Advices on general occupational hygiene:

Wash hands before breaks and after work.

Wash contaminated clothing before reuse.



Street clothing should be stored seperately from work clothing. Remove contaminated, saturated clothing immediately. Work in well ventilated zones or use proper respiratory protection. In the immediate working surroundings there must be: Provide eye shower and label its location conspicuously.

7.2 <u>Conditions for safe storage, including any incompatibilities</u>

Keep container tightly closed in a dry, cool, and well-ventilated place.
Keep container in upright position in order to prevent leakage.
Requirements for storage rooms and vessels:
Store locked up.
Use isolated drainage to prevent discharge to soil.
Ensure adequate ventilation of the storage area.
Advice on joint storage:

Keep away from food, drink and animal feedingstuffs.


