4. FIRST-AID MEASURES.

4.1. Description of first aid measures.

If inhaled:

Keep patient calm, remove to fresh air, seek medical attention.

On skin contact:

If irritation appears, remove any contaminated clothing . Wash affected areas thoroughly with soap and water.
